SUBJECT: **CONDUCT OF INTER-DIVISION VALIDATION AND MONITORING OF
DELIVERED LEARNING RESOURCES (LRs) AND IMPLEMENTATION OF
LIBRARY HUBS AND SCHOOL LIBRARIES**

DATE: **January 2, 2020**

1. The Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR) through the DepEd Regional Office XII will conduct the Inter-Division Validation and Monitoring of Delivered Learning Resources (LRs) and Implementation of Library Hubs and School Libraries on January 13-17, 2020 as specified in Region Memorandum CLMD No. 148, s.2019.
2. This activity aims to validate and conduct a post-delivery audit of all delivered LR; monitor the implementation of library hubs and school libraries; and gather data on LR inventory and consolidated mother-tongue reports in schools.
3. Participants to this activity are all Elementary Cluster Heads, PDO-II (LRMDS), Division Supply Officer, and Ma. Teresita H. Escobia, P-II. All participants are requested to report to Gen. Santos City (specific venue TBA) on Day 1 (January 13, 2020) at exactly 8:00 A.M. for the orientation and briefing before reporting to the assigned division. Moreover, participants are advised to return to Gen. Santos City on January 17, 2020 (Day 5), 8:00 AM for debriefing and submission of reports gathered.
4. Anent this, this Division is tasked to conduct the monitoring activity in Kidapawan City Division and at the same time will host the monitoring team from Cotabato City Division on the same dates.
5. Transportation, per diem and other incidental expenses of the participants relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against BLR Funds downloaded to the Region and School Division Offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
