SUBJECT: ORIBITATION ON IMPLEMENTATION OF DEWORMING AND

FILARIASIS MASS DRUG ADMINISTRATION AND SCHOOL BASED

IMMUNIZATION

DATE: June 22, 2018

- 1. Worms infect more than one third of the world's population, with the most intense infections in children and the poor. Only rarely does an infection have acute consequences for the children. Instead, the infection is long term and chronic, and can negatively affect all aspects of child development: health, nutrition, cognitive development, learning and educational access and achievement. Regular deworming contributes to good health and nutrition for children of school age, which in turn leads to increased enrolment and attendance, reduced class repetition and increased educational attainment.
- 2. Thus, the expanded Program on Immunization (EPI) has focused on the provision of free vaccines for infants since 1975. However, protection provided by some of these vaccines will decline over time and booster doses are required to ensure high levels of protection are maintained. New vaccines such as human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine are more effective if delivered at a specific age. It is important the health service providers take every

available opportunity to deliver vaccines and start vaccination for the school children and adolescent enrolled.

- 3. In relation to the conduct of the National School Deworming Month (1ST Round) and Filariasis Mass Drug Administration in the month of July and School-Based Immunized Program in the month of August and in collaboration with the Rural Health Unit Nurses of the Department of Health, please find herewith the schedule of Orientation on the Implementation of the said programs of all schools. Participants are PARENTS/GUARDIANS of all learners.
- 4. In this view, all School Heads are enjoined to ensure the participation of the parents/guardians through massive dissemination or employ other strategy.
