**SUBJECT: SECOND ROUND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL SCHOOL  
DEWORMING MONTH (NSDM) FOR SY 2019-2020**

**DATE: December 13, 2019**

1. In relation to the conduct of the Second Round of the National Schools Deworming Month (NSDM) for SY 2019-2020 from Kinder to Grade 12 and in collaboration with the Department of Health, this is to announce to the field the schedule of each school for such activity which is found in the enclosure.
2. The activity aims to reduce the burden of Soil Transmitted Helminthiasis Infection and eradicate the incidence of Lymphatic Filariasis and Schistosomiasis.
3. The school deworming activity requires **strict compliance of Parent's Consent** hence, the school clinic in-charge is expected to lead the activity and secure consent forms duly signed by the parents/guardians before deworming activity. The consent used on the first dose will serve as their permit on the second dose. Thus, retrieval of consents must be done by the advisers/ clinic in-charge.
4. It should be emphasized that the **learners had taken their meals prior to the administration**. Clean drinking water should be available per classroom.
5. For private schools, learners may be accommodated in the NSDM provided that a letter of intent addressed to the City Health Office is received from the school head.
6. Anent thereto, the undersigned enjoins all schools to continue advocating the advantages of this undertaking to the school community and other stakeholders and to ensure that all identified students shall be dewormed on the scheduled date.
7. Reports will be submitted by the Clinic in-charge on or before February 3, 2020 using the templates attached hereto.
