- The participants to this Congress are as follows: Division Chiefs, Education Supervisors, Division Section Heads, SGOD Personnel, School Heads, Master Teachers, Teachers and BERF recipients who have completed their research projects.



- Anent to this, all clusters and secondary schools are required to conduct Research Congress. All researches should be anchored on the Basic Education Research Agenda (DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2016 or the Adoption of the Basic Education Research Agenda. which have the following themes: Teaching and Learning, Child Protection, Human Resource Development, and Governance cum Cross-Cutting areas which are designed to provide guidance to DepEd and its stakeholders in the conduct of education research to ensure evidence-based planning, policy formulation, and program development aligned with the department's vision, mission and core values.
- Winners in the Cluster and Secondary School Congress shall participate in the Division Research Congress with complete entries per theme.
- The 2019 Division Research Congress Guidelines is enclosed as reference to provide the details of the said Congress. For the Best Implementers it should be based on the Action Plan.

2018 DIVISION RESEARCH CONGRESS GUIDELINES

- The research congress is open to all research practitioners and enthusiasts in the Department of Education particularly Division Supervisors, School Heads, Teachers and Non-Teaching Personnel.
- 2. The Congress shall focus on showcasing Educational and Action Researches conducted in the school and division levels to address problems related to access, quality and governance of basic education focusing on the following themes based on the National Basic Education Research Agenda - Theme 1: Teaching and Learning; Theme 2: Child Protection; Theme 3: Human Resource Development; and Theme 4: Governance.
- One copy of the full version of the paper which shall not exceed 3,500 words (about 10 pages in double space, using A4 size bond paper with "Arial" font style, and font size "12" shall be submitted before the conduct of the Congress. Deadline will be on September 17, 2018 and emailed it through its official division email at tacurong.city@deped.gov.ph and at ernie.pama@deped.gov.ph. Please follow strictly the format.
- 5. The research proponent shall use the DepEd prescribed outline for Action Research described below.
- 6. The Action Research should contain the following parts:

 - Abstract (not more than 200 words)

- 7 Paper Presenters shall be guided by the following pointers:
- The Oral Presentation shall last for 15 minutes per Oral Presenter with 5 minutes for open forum.
 - b. The availability of LCD projector shall be provided by the organizer.
- Presenters may distribute hand-outs / brochure to interested participants after C. the presentation.
- Each Paper Presenter for Oral Presentation will present the substance of the 8 following: Introduction; Research Questions/Objectives; Conceptual Framework (only if necessary); Methodology & Research Design; Summary of Results & Discussion; and Conclusion & Recommendations/Reflections or Implications
- For Poster Presentation, presenters are advised to use vertical (portrait) lay out at 48x36 inches size. Font size should not less than Arial 18. Poster should include the Title; Abstract; Context and Rationale; Action Research Questions; Innovation. Intervention and Action Research Methods; Results & Discussions; Conclusions Strategy: Recommendation, and References. Poster Presenters shall prepare his/her own poster stand. It shall be displayed on the designated area the day before the congress proper.


