





1. Please be informed that the Division Roll-Out on DRRM Standardized Modules for DRRM Coordinators/Alternate will be on November 5-8, 2019 which will be held at Paraiso Verde Resort, Koronadal City.
2. The activity aims to
 - 2.1 Develop the DRRM competencies of DepEd teaching and non-teaching staff particularly the School DRRM Coordinators;
 - 2.2 Equip the DRRM Coordinators with knowledge and skills on DRRM Modules and enable them to share and implement in their areas of work; and
 - 2.3 Strengthen the teamwork and camaraderie of the School DRRM Coordinators while the Division Coordinator are collaboratively doing the Roll Out of DRRM Manuals to their selected DRRM Coordinators
3. Expenses to be incurred relative to this four-day Division Roll-out shall be chargeable against Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
