URGENT CALL FOR HELP FOR EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS

- 1. In view of the devastation experienced by a remarkable number of people in Makilala, Tulunan and Kidapawan City brought about by the series of earthquakes which hit our region, an emergency meeting was called by Undersecretary Alain del Pascua and some technical personnel from the Central Office on November 2, 2019 at Makilala National High School, Division of Cotabato. The purpose was to assess the schools which were gravely affected and to come up with contingency action.
- 2. As a result and in recognition of the gravity and urgency to extend assistance to the learners and teachers of the identified and assigned as adopted schools of our Division, to wit: Datu Umpan Elementary School and Datu Saliman Elementary School, all of Kidapawan City Division, this Office hereby enjoins all personnel of this Division from public and private schools to show our deep concern and generosity.
- 3. It is in this premise that the urgent call and appeal to help earthquake victims through a voluntary contribution is apt.
- 4. In particular, the two schools which were totally damaged and no longer safe shall be replaced by temporary learning centers (TLC) to be constructed in the identified temporary learning spaces.

- 5. Hence, CSDT personnel (teaching and non teaching) are expected to willingly contribute a minimum of P200.00 each for the much needed structure and for additional food provisions.
- 6. All Supreme Pupil and Student Government (SPG/SSG) Officers through the Advisers are as well enjoined to collect any assistance (in cash or goods) to augment the required resources.
- 7. Schools which will contribute goods such as trapal, canned goods, etc., may charge the amount against the school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. Financial assistance shall be remitted to the Division Cashier on or before November 6, 2019.
- 9. Private schools are as well advised to join in this undertaking.
