1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services- School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), issued the **Institutional Guidelines on the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP)** in compliance with the provisions of R.A. No. 11037 or the “Masustansyang Pagkain Para sa Batang Pilipino Act,” the primary statutory basis for the implementation of SBFP.
2. As agreed during the virtual orientation conducted on September 4, 2023, the feeding shall start on September 19, 2023.
3. In line with this, the Elementary School Heads through the School-Based Feeding Coordinator are advised to submit the proposal for the downloading of SBFP operational expense on or before September 12, 2023. Attached is the list of computed operational expenses allotted per school.
