RXII PARTICIPANTS FOR 2024 NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Division Journalism Coordinators

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order (DO) No.94, s.1992 titled Promulgating the Rules and Regulations Necessary for the Effective Implementation of RA 7079 Otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991”, which stipulates the holding of annual national elementary and secondary schools press conference, and with reference to DepEd Memorandum No.025, s.2024, the Department of Education - SOCCSKSARGEN shall participate in the **2024 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC)** with the theme, **“Galing, Talino at Husay ng mga Batang Makabansa sa Diwa ng MATATAG na Adhika”** on **July 8-12, 2024**, (exclusive of travel time) in Carcar City, Cebu.

2. The conference aims to:
a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
c. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students’ interest in Journalism as a career; and
d. promote responsible journalism experiences and ethical use of social media

3. The qualifiers for the NSPC are the following:

Individual Categories	Top one regional winner per medium
Group Categories	One team per medium (Composed of seven members each team except for online publishing with five members)
School Paper Category	Top 10 regional winners per section per medium

4. The Official Regional delegation shall consist of 185 participants. **The delegates are expected to be at the venue on July 7, 2024. The first meal shall be dinner on July 7 and the last meal shall be afternoon snack on July 12.**

5. **For TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting contestants, an orientation will be conducted on July 7, 2024.** Details of the venue shall be relayed through the Regional Supervisor in charge of Campus Journalism a week before the orientation.

6. There will be simultaneous sessions related to new media. The participants to attend the concurrent session will be ten (10) secondary campus journalists, five (5) in English and five (5) in Filipino, and ten (10) School Paper Advisers, who are all official delegates to attend the session. Please see enclosure 2 for the distribution of participants.

All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.
