Pursuant to DM-OUOPS-2025-10-01059 titled Career Guidance Program (CGP) Curriculum Exits Tracking System for School Year (S.Y.) 2024-2025 and conduct of Localized Career Expo, all School Guidance Counselors/Designates, Career Advocates and Grade 12 Section Advisers with the assistance from the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) Officers and their respective Teacher-Advisers, are enjoined to inform SHS graduates for SY 2024-2025 to complete the Curriculum Exits Tracking System via the following link: <https://tinyurl.com/CETS-SY2024-2025> which was opened on February 26, 2025.

Further, in preparation for the National Career Expo (NCEX) 2025, all secondary schools are encouraged to conduct a Localized Career Expo (LCEx) throughout the months of March and April 2025 which may include career caravans, career fairs, and similar activities that provide learners with career guidance and opportunities highlighting the four curriculum exits such as higher education, employment, entrepreneurship, and middle level skills development.
3. All Guidance Counselors/Designates/Career Advocates are requested to submit an After Activity Report including photos or video documentation for the LCEx not later than April 11, 2025 for consolidation and submission to Regional YFD Coordinator.
4. Expenses in the conduct of the CGP activities will be charged to School MOOE or any available resources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
