**CONDUCT OF SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON PHILIPPINES' MARITIME RIGHTS
AND PROMOTING NATIONAL AWARENESS ON WEST PHILIPPINE SEA**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. This is in reference to the letter from **Commodore Jay T. Tarriela**, Commander of Philippine Coast Guard- West Philippine Sea Transparency Group (WPSTG), dated August 20, 2025, regarding the conduct of a series of regional engagements with public school teachers and students as part of the government's whole-of-nation approach in asserting the Philippines' maritime rights and promoting national awareness on WPS issues.

2. The WPSTG will spearhead a regional program composed of two components on **October 18, 2025 at General Santos City**:

a. **Morning Session** – Screening of the documentary “Food Delivery Fresh from the West Philippine Sea” for selected students; and

b. **Afternoon Session** – Seminar-workshop on the WPS, specifically designed for Social Studies teachers. This session aims to deepen teachers' understanding of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS), the 2016 Arbitral Award, and the official Philippine position on the WPS, with the end goal enriching classroom instruction.

3. In line with this initiative, SDOs are requested to identify 300 teachers and 100 students to participate in the said activity with the following breakdown of participants per division:

4. The film viewing/ documentary screening will happen at **KCC Cinema** while the seminar-workshop will be at **SM Trade Hall, General Santos City**.



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5. Food, venue and cinema viewing will be shouldered by Philippine Coast Guard Management while traveling and other incidental expenses incurred by the RO and SDOs shall be charged against their respective MOOE or any available local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. As the activity falls on a Saturday, teachers who shall be participating will be granted service credits as per DO 53, s. 2023, titled "Updated Guidelines in the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to teachers." They are likewise required to secure parent's permits or any necessary documented information for the learners that they will be bringing to join in the activity.
