- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10157, otherwise known as the Kindergarten Education Law, which mandates that all five (5)-year-old children shall be given equal opportunities to access Kindergarten Education to effectively promote their physical, social, emotional, and intellectual development, including values formation, and recognizing that children who participate in quality early childhood education perform better in school and become productive members of the community, the City Schools Division of Tacurong will conduct a one-day Festival of Talents for Kindergarten learners on November 4, 2025, at the City Cultural and Sports Center, Tacurong City.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a) showcase the potential of kindergarten children to strengthen their confidence and self-esteem;
 - b) enhance the developmental standards expected of five-year-old learners through various activities;
 - c) ensure the holistic development of young children in the physical, social, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual domains; and
 - d) promote camaraderie, sportsmanship, and love for learning.
- 3. The participants are all Kindergarten pupils and teachers. A registration fee of Fifty Pesos (₱50.00) shall be collected from both teachers and learners to cover incidental expenses such as tarpaulin, decorations, supplies, medals, and meals. Transportation and food for all participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 4. Attached as *Enclosure 1* are the general guidelines and criteria for the different contests.

MECHANICS, GENERAL GUIDELINES, AND CRITERIA FOR THE DIFFERENT CONTESTS

A. Contestants

 Contestants must be bona fide Kindergarten pupils from both public and private elementary schools within the Division.

B. General Guidelines

- The festival is open to all elementary schools, both public and private.
 Each cluster of public elementary schools shall have only one (1) entry per contest.
- A drawing of lots shall be conducted prior to the start of the contest proper.
- All presentations or deliveries with time limits shall be monitored by a
 designated timekeeper, who will be introduced before the start of the
 contest. Corresponding point deductions shall be applied for every
 minute of overtime.
- The mechanics and criteria of each contest event shall be strictly observed and followed.
- Only the teacher-coaches are authorized to coordinate with the management for any inquiries or clarifications.
- The decision of the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable.

MASS DANCE

Participants:

• 35 learners + 5 teachers per cluster/school

Mechanics:

- Perform a joyful group dance using remix Christmas-themed music
- Each group has 5-8 minutes for their performance, which includes entrance, exit, and prop preparations.
- · Wear division color-coded costumes with safe, colorful, and festive props
- **Teachers** will participate in the group dance with the learners, but they must not lead or dominate the overall performance.
- The dance should **creatively integrate literacy and numeracy concepts** (e.g., counting steps, forming letters).
- Submit CDs or USBs to the operator 30 minutes or earlier before the performance time to minimize delays and technical issues.
- A ranking method will be utilized to determine the winner. However, in the event of a tie, the individual judges' score sheets will be recalculated to resolve the tie.
- · Judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

TRACING, COLORING, AND WRITING COMPETITION

Objectives

- 1. To strengthen the fine motor skills of Kindergarten learners through ageappropriate activities.
- 2. To encourage creativity, neatness, and handwriting readiness among young learners.
- 3. To showcase the learners' progress in early literacy and artistic development.

General Guidelines

- 1. Each Division shall send one (1) Kindergarten learner-participant
- 2. The contest piece (worksheet containing tracing, coloring, and writing tasks) will be provided by the organizers.
- 3. Participants must bring their own coloring materials (crayons), pencil, and eraser.
- 4. The proper contest shall last for 60 minutes.
- 5. Contest facilitators will strictly monitor the participants. No assistance from teachers, coaches, or parents is allowed during the competition.
- 6. All submitted outputs will be coded to ensure fairness and impartiality in judging.

Mechanics

- 1. **Tracing** Participants will trace given shapes, lines, or letters following the correct stroke order and neatness.
- 2. **Coloring** Participants will color a picture provided, using appropriate colors and observing neatness.
- 3. **Writing** Participants will copy/write assigned letters, words, or a short sentence with proper strokes and legibility.
- 4. All tasks must be completed within the time limit.
- 5. After the time is up, facilitators will collect all outputs for judging.

Contest Objectives

- 1. The contest aims to **inspire creativity** among young participants.
- 2. We encourage talent development through engaging activities and performance opportunities.
- 3. This event fosters a **strong community spirit** by bringing families together.

Guidelines

- 1. Maximum Performance Time Up to five minutes (5)
- 2. Required Materials List provided prior
- 3. Registration Process Complete by deadline
- All kindergarten students are invited to participate. Individuals and entrants are welcome, but all submissions must adhere to the **contest themes** outlined in the guideline
- > Each entry will be evaluated based on how effectively it engages the audience and communicates its message.

THE LITTLE DREAMER

ALPHABETICAL KNOWLEDGE - Alphabet Relay Race (CVC Word Formation)

Guidelines:

- The contest is open to Kindergarten pupils.
- Player must line up at the starting line and must wait for their turn.
- Player must run safely (no pushing, shoving, or skipping turns).
- The contest has 3 rounds of difficulty:
 - Easy Round Beginning Sounds/Letters
 - Medium Round Middle Sounds/Letters
 - Difficult Round Ending Sounds/Letters
- Each round will have 5 items only.
- Contestants must answer within the given time limit (e.g., 10 seconds).
- Teachers/facilitators will supervise to ensure fairness and safety.
- Audience participation is encouraged through cheers and claps.
- In case of a tie, a tie-breaker round will be played (see below).

Mechanics:

- > At the far end of the playing area, place picture cards or objects inside baskets labeled per round.
- The player must identify the item and give the required sound and letter name:
 - \bigcirc Easy Round (Beginning Sound/Letter) \rightarrow First sound (e.g., "Ball /b/").
 - \bigcirc Medium Round (Middle Sound/Letter) \rightarrow Vowel sound in the middle (e.g., "Pen middle sound/letter /e/").
 - Difficult Round (Ending Sound/Letter) \rightarrow Final sound (e.g., "Dog ending Sound/letter/g/").
- The teacher/judge checks if the answer is correct.
- The round ends when all 5 items are identified correctly.
- After all 3 rounds, scores will be tallied.
- > The player with the highest score wins.
- > Tie-breaker Rule:

A bonus item will be shown to the tied teams.

The first player to give the correct sound (beginning, middle, or ending, as announced by the judge) wins.

Materials:

Letter Cards

Big, colorful, laminated cards with consonants and vowels. At least 2–3 sets so multiple teams can play.

Letters should be bold and easy to read for kids.

Word List / Cue Cards

Prepared CVC words (e.g., cat, dog, sun, hat, pen, bed). Teacher/facilitator uses these to announce the target word.

Baskets or Boxes

For holding the letter cards at the "letter station."

Labeled as Beginning Sound, Middle Sound, Ending Sound (optional).

> Relay Markers

Cones, tape, or chairs to mark the starting line and letter station.

Word Board / Mat

A pocket chart, magnetic board, flannel board, or even a mat/table where kids

arrange the letters to form the word.

Whistle / Bell

To signal the start and end of each round.

Score Sheet & Pen

For teachers/judges to tally points based on accuracy, teamwork, speed, and

sportsmanship.

GUIDELINES:

- Eligibility: Open to any existing KINDERGARTEN of the school Year 2025-2026
- Participant must register before the deadline
- Jigsaw puzzles with large, easy-to-handle pieces.
- * 12-24 pieces (Let's make it challenging but still fun!).
- The puzzle image should be bright, cheerful, and related to the theme "Little Stars, Dreaming Big, and Embracing the Joy of Learning!".

To encourage participants to observe, interpret, and express their thoughts creatively and critically based on a given image

- 1) Open to any existing KINDERGARTEN of the school Year 2025-2026
- 2) Participants must register before the deadline
- 3) Each participant will be shown a picture (digital or printed). They will be given [5–10 minutes] to observe the image. After observation, participants will have [3–5 minutes] to present their interpretation verbally or in writing (depending on format).
- 4) No use of mobile phones or reference materials during the competition. Participants must not copy or repeat others' interpretations. Time limits must be strictly followed. Respectful and appropriate language must be used

JUDGING CRITERIA

Participants will be evaluated based on:
