I. GUIDELINES FOR QUARTET CONTEST

The Quartet Contest aims to showcase the musical talent, harmony, and creativity of SDO personnel through group performances. Each quartet will perform a music remix, demonstrating vocal skill, synchronization, and stage presence. This contest encourages teamwork, musical arrangement skills, and audience engagement.

1. Participants Composition

- Each quartet shall be composed of:
 - Four (4) female members, or
 - · Four (4) male members, or
 - Two (2) female and two (2) male members.
 - All members of the quartet must belong to the same cluster.
 - Only one entry per cluster is allowed and one entry for the division office

2. Performance Piece

- o The group shall perform a music remix of their choice.
- The remix may include a combination of songs or creative arrangements, provided it maintains appropriate and wholesome content.

3. Performance Duration

- The presentation shall last for a minimum of three (3) minutes and a maximum of five (5) minutes.
- Exceeding or falling short of the time limit will result in corresponding 2-point deductions from the total score.

4. Criteria for Judging

- Vocal Quality / Harmony 40%
- Creativity and Originality of Remix 30%
- Stage Presence and Coordination 20%
- o Audience Impact 10%

Total: 100%

5. Other Guidelines

- Background tracks or live accompaniment are allowed.
- Costumes and props are permitted but must be appropriate and relevant to the performance.
- o The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

II. RETRO CONTEST GUIDELINES (With a Twist of Comedy or "Aliw" Factor)

The Retro Contest aims to showcase the creativity, energy, and entertainment value of each cluster through dance performances inspired by past decades. To make the presentation more engaging, each group is encouraged to incorporate a comedy twist, lip-synch, or any form of "Aliw" factor that will delight the audience.

1. Participants

- 1. Each cluster is entitled to one (1) entry only.
- 2. Each participating group must consist of a minimum of fifteen
- (15) and a maximum of thirty (30) dancers.

2. Performance Guidelines

- The performance must be based on a Retro theme featuring music, costumes, and dance styles inspired by earlier decades (e.g., 60s, 70s, 80s, or 90s).
- 2. Each performance must include a twist of comedy, lip-synch, or any other "Aliw" factor to add humor, creativity, and audience engagement.
- 3. The duration of the performance shall be not less than four (4) minutes and not more than seven (7) minutes, including entrance and exit.
- 4. The music may be a remix or medley of retro songs.
- 5. Use of props, costumes, and backdrops is encouraged, provided they are safe, appropriate, and relevant to the theme.
- 6. Any indecent, vulgar, or offensive acts, lyrics, or gestures are strictly prohibited.
- 7. Performances exceeding or falling short of the time limit shall incur 2 point deductions from the total score.

3. Criteria for Judging

Criteria	Percentage
Choreography and Creativity	30%
Retro Theme and Costume	25%
Comedy or "Aliw" Factor	25%
Coordination and Stage Presence	20%
Total	100%

4. Other Provisions

- 1. Participants may use live or recorded music.
- 2. Technical preparations (e.g., sound test, props setup) must be coordinated with the committee beforehand.
- 3. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

4. All clusters must uphold sportsmanship, creativity, and teamwork throughout the competition.

III. TikTok Dance Contest Guidelines

The TikTok Dance Contest aims to promote camaraderie, creativity, and fun among school heads and section heads/EPSs through dance performances. Participants will showcase their coordination, rhythm, and energy while performing a TikTok-inspired dance to a remix music of their choice. The contest emphasizes teamwork, creativity, and audience engagement.

1. Participants

- Each cluster shall have only one entry.
- Each entry must consist of a minimum of 5 school heads/section heads/EPS and a maximum of all school heads/section heads/EPS per cluster.
- Participants must be official school heads from the same cluster and section heads/EPS from division office.

2. Performance Duration

- o Each dance performance must last 3 to 5 minutes.
- o TikTok-style dance moves and trends are encouraged.
- Music remix is allowed, and participants can use multiple songs as long as the total performance fits within the time limit.

3. Judging Criteria

Performances will be evaluated based on:

- 1. Creativity & Originality (30%) Dance moves, choreography, and music remix integration.
- 2. Synchronization & Coordination (25%) Teamwork, timing, and fluidity of movements.
- 3. Stage Presence & Energy (20%) Confidence, engagement, and audience appeal.
- 4. Adherence to Rules (15%) Number of participants, duration, and proper registration.
- 5. Overall Impact (10%) Overall impression and entertainment value.

4. Performance Rules

- Dance props are optional, but must be safe and appropriate.
- o Music should be appropriate for a professional school environment.
- Performances exceeding 5 minutes or less than 3 minutes will be penalized.

- Participants must arrive at the venue 30 minutes before their performance.
- o Judges' decisions are final and non-appealable.
- All participants must maintain professional decorum while participating in the contest.
